SCHOOL PROCEDURE FOR INFORMING PARENTS OF COVID CASES

The school will inform parents by Seesaw message that a COVID case been identified in their pupil's class.

Even if your child has no new symptoms, we are asking pupils to undertake a Lateral Flow test (LFT) at home before coming back into school.

If the Lateral Flow test is negative, and your child has no symptoms, your child can return to school. If the Lateral Flow test is positive your child should isolate immediately and is now to be treated as a case of COVID-19. They do not need to have a PCR test. PLEASE NOTIFY THE SCHOOL IF POSITIVE.

If the Lateral Flow test is negative but your child develops new symptoms, YOUR CHILD MUST STAY AT HOME. Please book a PCR test online at www.gov.uk/get-coronavirus-test or by phoning 119.

Where a cluster of cases has been identified in a class, an additional letter will be sent to parents.
